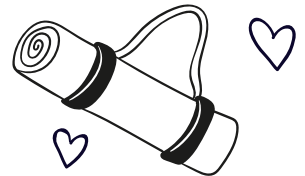
My motivation to be an English Pal

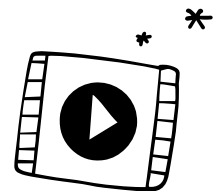
My motivation to be an English Pal

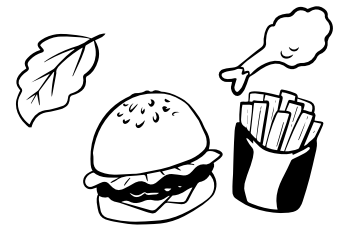

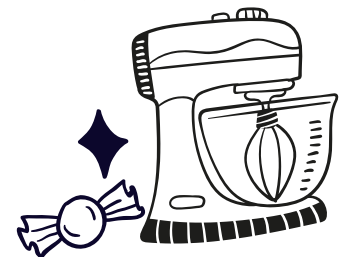
My motivation to be an English Pal

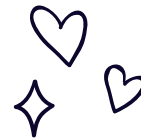
My motivation to be an English Pal

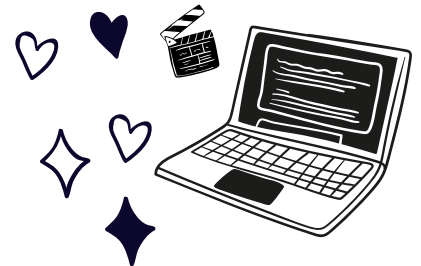

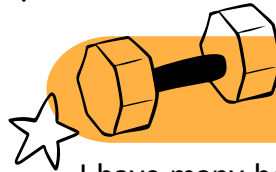

My motivation to be an English Pal

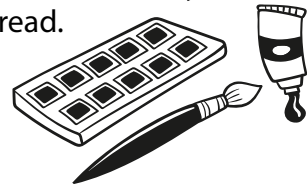
